

World Language Placement

- **What if my son has already taken a world language course?**

Students currently enrolled in a first-year world language course are eligible to take the world language placement test to assess their readiness for a second-year course (general or honors). The completed language course must be a **full year course to qualify** and should be equivalent to a high school course in seat hours and rigor. Elementary programs that meet a couple days a week do not count as a first-year world language substitute.

- **When is the world language placement test?**

- *To qualify, a student must have taken a high school-level Spanish I or Chinese I class or higher.*
- There is no charge for this test. The test will be in the Iott Center on Tuesday, March 19 from 4pm-5pm. We will email your test results and Language placement.

Math Placement

- **How will my son get placed into a math class?**

Students who are currently enrolled in Pre-Algebra or a Math 8 course will be enrolled in Algebra 1.

Students who are currently enrolled in Algebra 1 are eligible to sit for the math placement test. This test will determine mastery of Algebra 1. If there is a sufficient foundation to support advanced math, the student will be enrolled in Geometry or Honors Geometry, depending on the placement test score. St. John's Jesuit Academy students who are currently in an advanced course will be placed by their current instructor in coordination with the Math Chair.

- **When is the math placement test?**

- *To qualify, a student must have taken a high school-level Algebra I class or higher.*
- There is no charge for this test. The test will be in the Iott Center on Thursday, March 21 from 4 pm-5 pm. We will email your test results and math placement.
