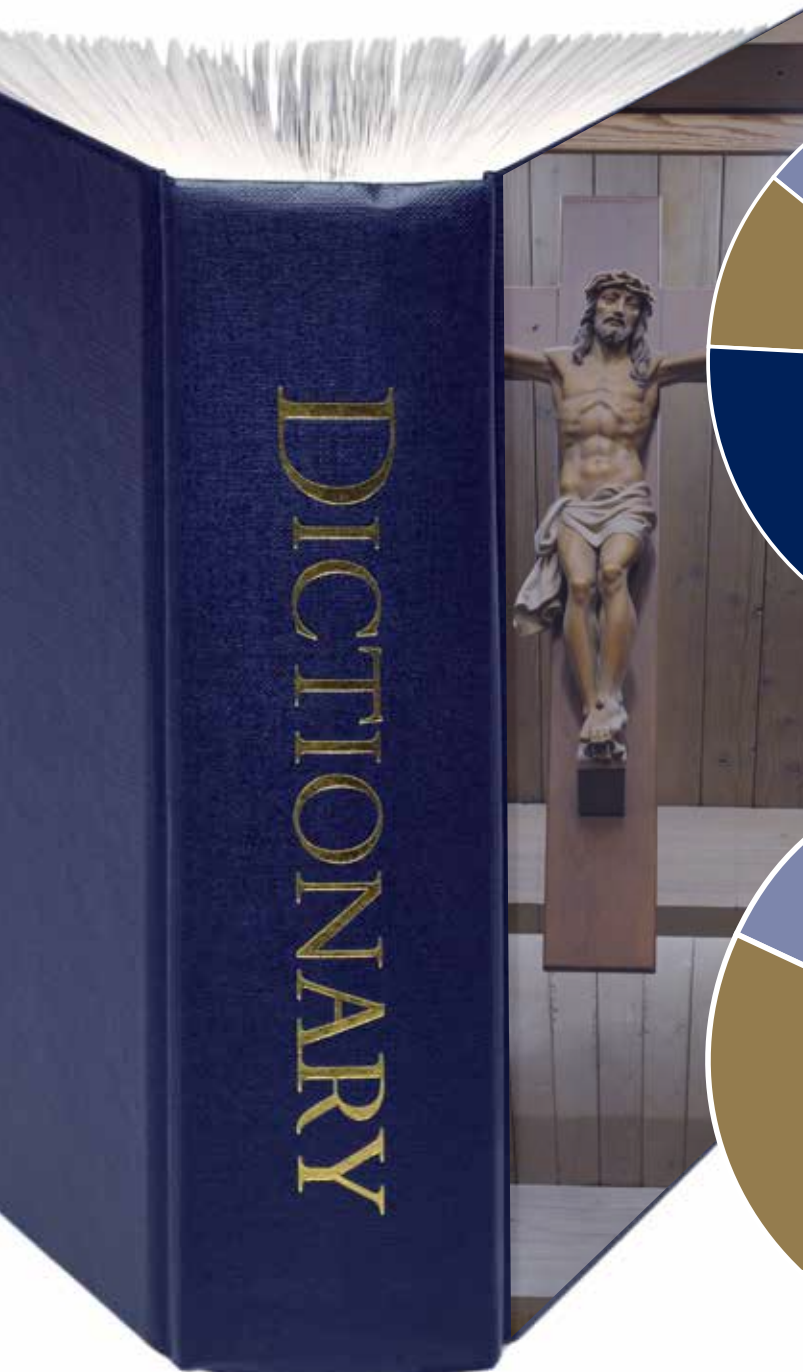

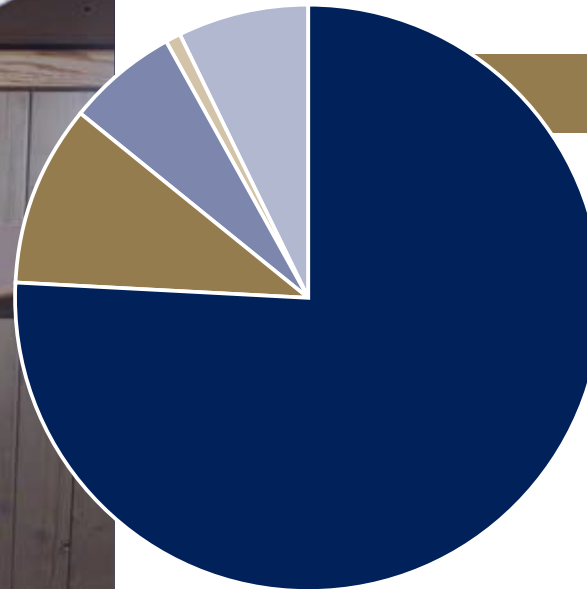

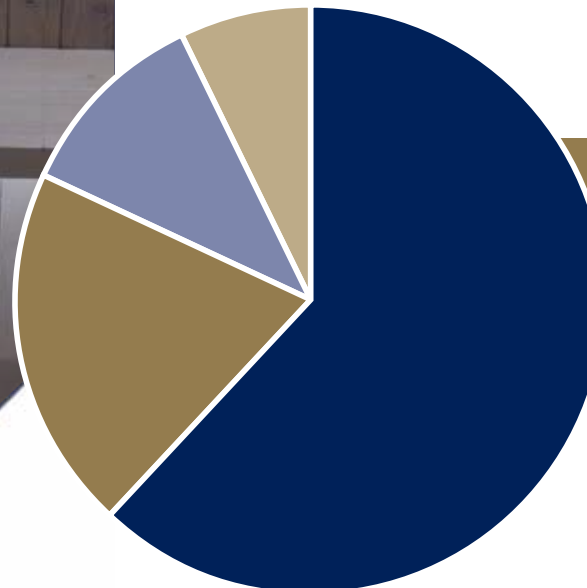


REVENUE *July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024*

EXPENSES *July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024*



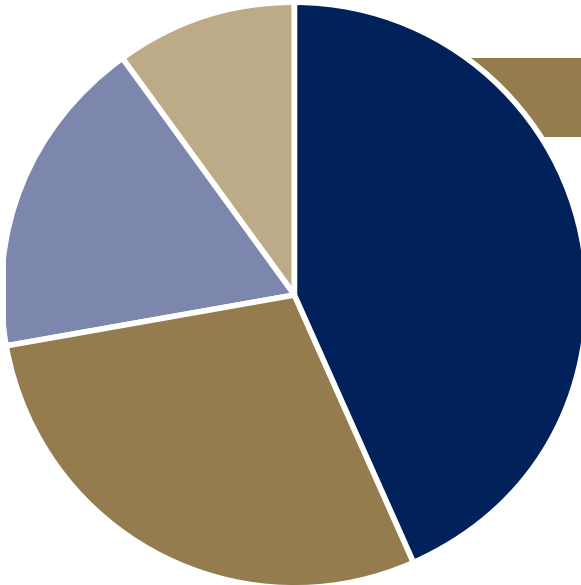

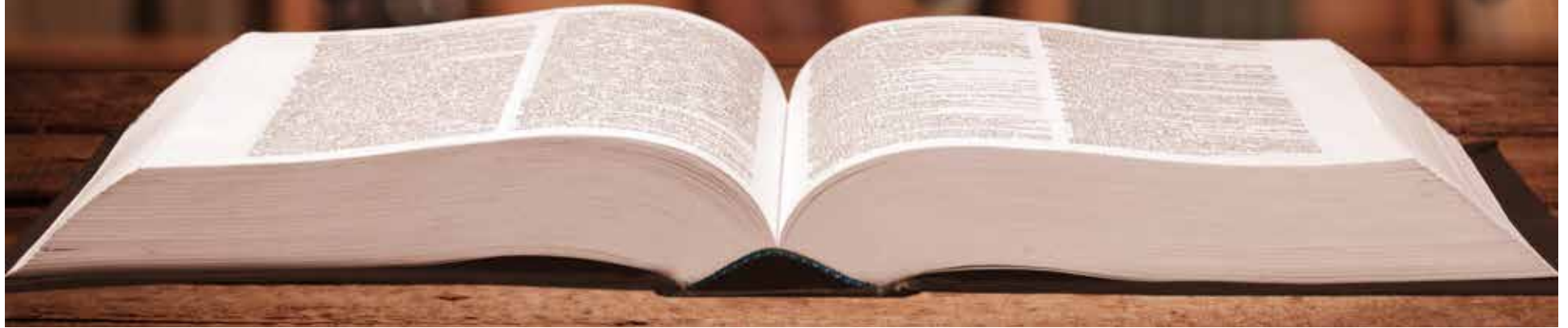

Defining our Future through Planned Giving



A planned gift ensures that St. John's Jesuit's mission of forming *Men for Others* in northwest Ohio is secure, no matter the economic or political landscape. Those who include SJJ in their estate planning are indeed a group of like-minded individuals who hope to make the school strong and resilient for years to come. Known as the St. John Berchmans Legacy Society, these supporters strongly believe in the future of the school. As SJJ's alumni population continues to grow, it is true that it is aging. In this regard, many of the earlier graduates are looking to support the school in ways they were unable to before. Those men, along with parents, grandparents, and friends of SJJ, make up a considerable group of people who can support SJJ through planned

giving techniques. Planned giving may come through several methods, including charitable bequests, annuities, stocks, life insurance policies, retirement plan assets, charitable trusts, and Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs). The Advancement Office at SJJ advises prospective donors to first consult with an attorney, accountant, or wealth planning professional to explore all the options. The Advancement Office will work diligently to make the process simple and transparent by initiating the gifting agreement with a simple form, known as a non-binding "Letter of Intent," to ensure your gift intentions are understood and acknowledged.

Futures Redefined by the Jesuit Scholars Program (JSP)



Gerri Peters assumed the role of Director of the Jesuit Scholars Program (formerly the 20/20 Jesuit Scholars Program) on July 1, 2024. Founded by Fr. Don Vettese, SJ, in the 1990s, the program has strived to provide under-resourced students with access to a St. John's Jesuit education for nearly 30 years. Under the close supervision of the program leader, students are provided with academic support, spiritual development, access to extracurricular opportunities, meals, and other support that will ensure a better future. Peters recently reflected on her first semester at SJJ and her hopes for the future of the Jesuit Scholars Program.



What motivated you to apply for the position of Director of the Jesuit Scholars Program?

I was looking for a place to marry my faith and sense of purpose with my many years of service to young people and their families.

What are the most important lessons you learned in the first semester of the school year?

St. John's Jesuit is a very busy place! Something new and exciting is always happening—including ways to learn and to help students in the Jesuit Scholars Program achieve the "Open to Growth" pillar.

It is obvious how seriously our students, faculty and staff take the mission of *Men For Others*. Through acts of service and leadership opportunities, we all help mold students into caring and intentional leaders.

What has been the most positive aspect of your role?

Sharing my faith gives me great joy, and the environment at SJJ allows me to do so daily. The young men are AMAZING. They are smart and driven, and they want to succeed! I quickly appreciated partnering with fellow SJJ colleagues to support both the social/emotional and academic needs of our students. I also immediately recognized how eager Titans are to embrace academic and personal goals. I see all these positive aspects of the Jesuit Scholars Program!

What has been surprising?

I pose a "Question of the Day," and the students really enjoy answering it!

What do you believe the JSP achieves for SJJ, as well as for the wider community?

JSP provides an opportunity for all students to attend, grow, and become the best version of themselves.

What are your immediate goals for the program?

My immediate goals are to support graduating seniors as they look for opportunities to make the most of the education they received at SJJ, as well as to build upon the mentoring lunches we started this year for the JSP freshmen. I hope to partner with the Office of College and Career Counseling again and take one more group of JSP juniors on an Ohio College Tour. I also want to celebrate the success of this year with our students by planning the annual JSP end-of-the-year banquet!

What are your long-term goals?

I plan to launch a JSP alumni mentor program for graduating seniors, as well as for high school and Academy students. I want to increase the number of students accepted into the program. As I learn more about the process at SJJ, I believe that strong collaboration with our Admissions Office and those who secure donor support in Advancement is key to achieving this goal. Last, I intend to identify more ways for JSP students to more deeply engage with the wider Toledo community.

What do you want supporters to know about the JSP?

The JSP plays a vital role within the SJJ community, supporting our students today as they grow into the leaders of tomorrow.

Lasting Meaning through Named Scholarships



Supporters of St. John's Jesuit can give to the school in several ways. The availability of more than 150 named scholarships is witness to the tradition and incredible love of the community. Every gift made in memory of an SJJ community member has a unique story impacted by Jesuit education that continues through those selected as recipients.

The story of Charles Kienzle '99 is no exception.



The Charles Smart Kienzle '99 Scholarship

Charles Kienzle, one of four Kienzle brothers to attend St. John's Jesuit, was a proud member of the Class of 1999. He went on to earn a B.A. in Film & Television Production in 2005 from the University of Toledo. He moved to Los Angeles shortly thereafter to pursue his dream career in the entertainment industry. His career took him from the studios of Hollywood to worldwide festivals in Cannes, Monaco, Sundance, and Tribeca. He worked as a producer, writer, and manager. His proudest achievements included working on multiple major motion pictures, documentaries, television shows, and web series, and his projects included work for HBO, Viacom, Showtime, and more. He also started his own management company and produced a pilot for BBC America.

In 2014, at age 33, Kienzle lost his battle against a rare blood disorder. His death inspired his family to seek ways to honor the person he was and the way he impacted those around him. Kienzle had a vibrant personality—his charisma, charm, and uncanny sense of humor brightened the lives of those around him. His love of good conversation, art, film, delicious food, Red Wings hockey, football—as well as his ability to make people laugh—never subsided as he grew. Even in death, these traits remain the enduring hallmarks of his life. He was truly a one-of-a-kind person and lived life to its fullest.

Recently, Kienzle's mother, Susan, reflected on his named scholarship at St. John's Jesuit.

What was Charles' experience at St. John's, and how did this experience impact his growth and development?

To be honest, Charles did not want to attend SJJ. He had been in public schools previously, but we wanted his high school experience to include more personal development. Despite his

initial misgivings, he quickly began to immerse himself in SJJ, through playing soccer, then hockey, then working on the school musical, and at TV4. His Kairos retreat and his Senior Project were life-changing. I remember him reaching out to friends from his Kairos retreat during a troubled period in his life.

For his Senior Project, he spent three weeks working with a producer on a film project. SJJ programs like the Senior Project, TV4, and musicals increased and reinforced Charles' love for entertainment production.

In what ways did Charles carry his high school education with him into his college experience and beyond?

Charles entered college knowing how to analyze and write, particularly in his humanities classes. SJJ taught Charles a keen ability to dissect storytelling, narrative structure, and the interplay between themes and emotions. These abilities served him well in his professional career. When Charles would edit his clients' work, he would often use practices he learned from his SJJ English teacher, Mr. Harms. He worked patiently with many writers and helped them tell their stories.

Why was it important for you to establish the scholarship in his name?

We thought about Charles's life and decided that he was happiest while at SJJ. His younger brothers also attended SJJ, which gave us all a connection to the school. In addition, we wanted to feel an ongoing connection by getting to know about our scholarship recipient. We hope this scholarship gives other young men a chance to share in the critical development that Charles received at SJJ and to grow their passions for entertainment production.

What would you like recipients of the scholarship to know about Charles?

Charles was one of the most entertaining people you could ever know. He was a storyteller. He had story after story about his life in the entertainment industry, from his adventures in LA, to his travels to film festivals, most notably in Cannes. Charles also had a deep passion for film, art, and engaging people. If he wasn't watching a movie or reading a book, he was usually talking with someone about a movie or a book. Charles' passion for art and getting to know people fueled him and were a constant source of happiness in his life.

What qualities are important to you in the students who are selected to receive the Charles Smart Kienzle '99 Scholarship?

We would like the scholarship to be awarded to an upper classman who is engaged in the SJJ activities that Charles enjoyed and that relate to the career he chose. In particular, we would like the recipient to have an interest in audio and visual/TV4 production, theater, or art.

In 2021, SJJ awarded Ean Russell the Charles Smart Kienzle '99 Scholarship as a freshman. Now a senior, Russell knows the opportunity to be a Titan was only made possible through scholarship assistance. A varsity soccer player for four years, Russell has also excelled in digital photography and video, often capturing special events for the school. He has learned to balance a rigorous academic schedule with extracurriculars and work. He often reflects on the generosity of the scholarship, especially as graduation nears.

Where have you developed the most?

I feel that I have matured a lot. I am much better about time management and being responsible for assignments in class, as well as overall responsibilities outside of class.

What are your biggest takeaways from SJJ?

I am much more confident and have developed strong communications skills. Digital photography has allowed me to develop my creative talents. I know how to engage with all types of people. I feel ready for college, and I am not afraid to take on leadership.

What are your post graduate plans?

I have applied to the University of Cincinnati and the University of Toledo.

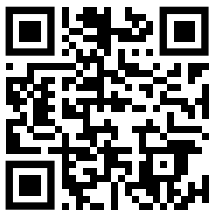

The Young Alumni Council (YAC) is an inclusive group of graduates who are younger than 40 and have come together to share their great passion for SJJ and its mission to develop Men for Others in northwest Ohio. Members of YAC are asked to pledge a gift for four consecutive years at one of three levels. The group meets quarterly, but may assist with student initiatives, scholarship fundraising, admissions, and alumni relations. Participants of YAC receive several benefits corresponding to their level of membership. In addition, social events planned throughout the year allow alumni to engage with fellow members and attract new alumni to the group.

Today, YAC has 42 members from all over the country who have collectively given more than \$500,000. All gifts made to YAC go directly to student programming which includes tuition assistance, travel for service trips, new educational initiatives, and fees associated with activities.

“In 2009, I was the only freshman to play on the top 7 of the Varsity tennis team. We were trying to win a state title that year. In the semifinals of the state championships, I lost the deciding match to the team that ultimately won the state title. I felt terrible that I had cost us the win in the semifinals, but we still had to play another match that day to

decide third place. Similar to earlier in the day, I was the final match on the court. I remember our entire team—particularly our two senior captains—cheering me on and supporting me as much as they could throughout the deciding moments of that match. 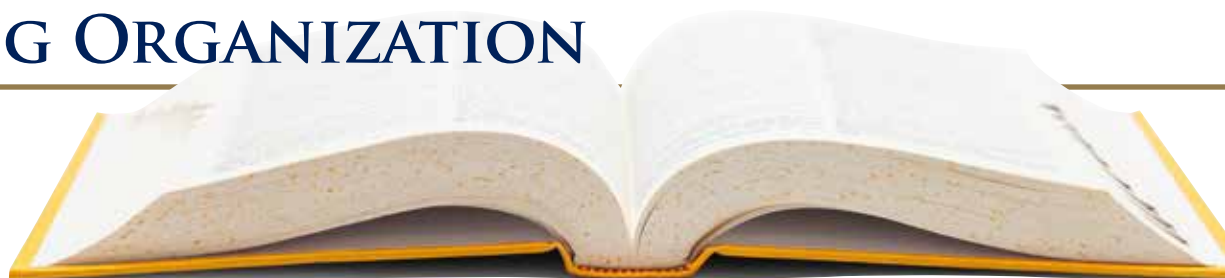

SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION

Your Tax Dollars Defined by a Gift to the St. John's Jesuit Scholarship Granting Organization



The St. John's Jesuit Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) was established as part of the Ohio Scholarship Tax Credit Program in 2023. An SGO is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that receives contributions from donors and grants educational scholarships to eligible students in the State of Ohio.

The SJJ SGO allows Titan supporters in Ohio to support tuition assistance at the school while also receiving a tax credit. It is a dollar-for-dollar credit, but is limited to \$750 for an individual or \$1,500 if married filing jointly. Gifts to the SGO will only be used to fund tuition assistance for current students. Families that are at or below 300 percent of the federal poverty level will be prioritized to receive assistance, but any student is eligible.

Alumni, friends, faculty, and staff have been excited to support the mission of SJJ in a new way, by giving to the SJJ SGO. President Karl Ertle said, "This is our second full year in the program, and we appreciate it because it allows us to give scholarship money directly to the students."

Paul Kwapich '09 was motivated to give to the SJJ SGO by his own experience and the close friendships he made as a student. "When I think back, there were likely classmates who would not have had the ability to attend St. John's without some financial assistance," he said. "Tuition assistance support enriches the entire student body."

60 YEARS WITH A RENEWED FOCUS ON THE FUTURE



St. John's Jesuit has never had a shortage of strong leadership. For nearly 60 years, the Jesuits have educated young men at SJJ to be compassionate critical thinkers. Alumni and many in the community closely tied to the school have dedicated themselves to advocating the mission of *Men for Others* in northwest Ohio.

In February 2024, the Midwest Province of Jesuits, under the direction of Rev. Karl Kiser, SJ, asked the Board of Directors to better align the expectations of membership to the Board of Directors to those of fellow

boards at other Jesuit schools across the country. As a member of the Jesuit School Network, SJJ holds an important place in the family tree of secondary schools in the United States. At Fr. 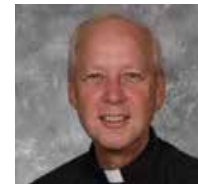
